





August - November: Orientation Phase of Transition

- Information is collected from your child's Primary School or Current School.
- Our Learning Mentors get to know every student's background.
- Students will have a learning mentor session at the start of every day
- Learning Mentors are the first point of contact for parents and they perform a pastoral care role giving students a home base.
