1. Purpose

The purpose of the Student Dress Code Policy is to outline Rowville Secondary College's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Rowville Secondary College's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code Policy aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- support Rowville Secondary College's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community.

The School Council has developed a Student Dress Code policy that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

2. Scope

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code Policy while travelling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities, except where explicitly waived (e.g., school camps, approved free dress days).

3. Policy

The wearing of college uniform by all students is compulsory in response to the strong and clear preference of parents and the community for such a policy. Rowville Secondary College is proud to have a school uniform that unites our school community, promotes a healthy lifestyle and identifies our students within the community.

The full list of Rowville Secondary College school uniform items is available at Appendix A to this policy.

3.1. General Appearance

Whilst at school, travelling to and from school or participating in school activities, Rowville Secondary College students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- Uniforms must be clearly marked with the owner's name

- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these undergarments are completely hidden.

3.2. Uniform Guidelines

Our school uniform consists of all activewear. Students are permitted to wear the approved uniform in both the classroom and active classes such as physical education and dance. We encourage students to bring additional uniform that they can change into after classes that involve vigorous physical activity.

There are no compulsory uniform items. Students may select the garments that most appeal to them and wear any combination at any time of the year. The uniform items are designed to be layered to create the level of warmth that suits each individual student.

The uniform is designed to be gender neutral, however, there are options for more fitted or loose fitting garments based on student preference.

3.3. Jewellery and cosmetics

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, and watches, (other than smart watches) are the only acceptable jewellery. Students who have a nose piercing may wear a discreet /or clear stud ONLY.

3.4. Hair and nails

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back during practical activities for student safety. Students must ensure that they maintain their fingernails to a standard to prevent the risk of injury to themselves or others during practical activities such as sport.

3.5. School Bag

It is strongly recommended that students use the school backpack available from the Rowville Secondary College Uniform Store. Students must use a sturdy, well-constructed bag that supports good posture when travelling to and from school. Tote bags or handbags are not acceptable.

3.6. Scarves

Students are permitted to wear scarves to school during winter months. Scarves must be navy blue. Oversized fashion scarfs are not permitted.

3.7. Caps and Sun safety

We expect students to take responsibility for being sun smart by wearing a school hat during outdoor activities or staying in the shade, if they are not wearing sunscreen.

A college cap is available from our uniform supplier. This is the only cap that can be worn at school. Caps are not to be worn in classrooms. "Beanies" and other types of hats are not acceptable.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet Australian Standard 1067:2016 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

3.8. Shoes

In recognition that many students have specific requirements in relation to footwear, the uniform does not include a prescribed shoe. However, for safety reasons, students are required to wear a sturdy and supportive shoe that has no heel or an insignificant heel and totally encloses the foot. High-heeled shoes, boots, sandals or thongs are not allowed.

Students must wear shoes that are fit for purpose and safe in a school environment. Consideration should be given to occupational health and safety requirements in practical classes such as technology, science, dance and physical education. It is recommended that shoes have non-slip soles, provide adequate foot support and offer protection from accidents such as dropping tools/equipment/materials on their feet, sole penetration from sharp objects such as screws/nails and spilling of hot liquids.

3.9. Socks

Socks must be plain coloured: blue, black, white or grey.

3.10. Purchase of Uniforms

OnTrack Sportswear is the official uniform supplier to Rowville Secondary College.

3.13. Support for families experiencing difficulty

3.14. Implementation

Rowville Secondary College will ensure that this Student Dress Code Policy is communicated to all families and students through our website and "School Documentation" on Compass [School Documentation | Compass](#). We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.

Students wearing non-compliant uniform items may be asked to change into a compliant item of clothing provided by the school. A chronicle entry noting this breach will be made on Compass.

If a student is out of school uniform or otherwise breaches the Student Dress Code on a recurring basis, contact may be made with the parents/guardians to discuss the issue. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.

Measures taken by Rowville Secondary College to address concerns about student non-compliance with the Student Dress Code will also be addressed in accordance with our Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy.

3.15. Exemptions to student dress code

We recognise that there may be situations where the application of this dress code may affect students unequally.

Students and their parents or carers may apply either in writing or in person to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:

- an aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic or cultural beliefs or background
- the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code
- the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular economic hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:

- consider the grounds for the exemption request
- explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers
- encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.

The Principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.
